MuZARDI is mandated to carry out applied and adaptive research for the Lake Victoria Crescent Agro-ecological Zone. It serves 22 districts of Central Uganda which is the most populous region with about 10 million people.

MuZARDI headquarter is located in Ntawo village, Mukono District 20 km East of Kampala City and 2 km off the Jinja-Kampala high way. The Institute has a satellite Center located in Kamenyamiggo, Lwengo district



- vii. Post-harvest and value-addition






